GENERAL RULES

All entries must be in writing, signed by owner or authorized agent, and accompanied by proper fees. Parent or guardian must sign the entry of a junior exhibitor.

Check policy: OPEN CHECKS will not be accepted with original entries. Full payment for classes entered and Office Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors wishing to add classes during the show may leave an OPEN CHECK (separate from their entry fees) at the show office. Scratched classes will not be deducted from any applicable fees. CHECKS RETURNED for any reason will be assessed a \$25.00 processing fee.

Exhibitors canceling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entry fee except in case of disability of horse or rider. Entry fees will be refunded (less office fee) only upon presentation to the Show Secretary a Certificate of Disability from a qualified Veterinarian/Physician prior to the first class the horse/rider is entered.

Post Entries: Should be made at least 3 classes prior to entering the arena.

Amateur Cards: Exhibitor must have either a WSH, USEF, or Breed amateur card, which will be inspected at the show unless a photocopy is included with the entry. In Amateur Classes, a current USEF, WSH, or Breed Amateur card is required, or application may be may with the show secretary at the of picking up show numbers. WSH will issue Amateur Cards for an annual fee. If the applicant is a member of WSH and participating in the annual WSH High Score awards competition there is no fee.

Registration Papers: Registration Papers (copies please) must accompany entry, and if horse is dual registered BOTH sets of papers must be submitted if entering a Breed class. "*" denotes classes requiring registration papers.

Conduct: Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry or an exhibitor or the participant of any agent, trainer, or rider who has shown an objectionable attitude toward a recognized show or pervious unsportsmanlike behavior at a recognized show or to its management. Show committee reserves the right to combine/cancel unfilled classes; accept entries of unfilled classes at a regular fee; divide classes as entries warrant. Exhibitors will be advised of combined and cancelled/divided classes.

Exhibitors must appear in the ring suitably attired, with correct numbers clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition; entries with incorrect or missing numbers will be disqualified. If an exhibitor voluntarily removes a horse from the ring without permission of the judge, the exhibitor may be disqualified from all future classes at the show by the show committee and forfeit all prizes and entry fees for the entire show.

Age of an individual on December 1, 2023, is maintained the entire year. For horse show purposes, a horse becomes one year old on January 1 following the actual foaling date.

Class Awards: Ribbons to 6th place will be given.

High Point Awards: High Point awards are as listed on the entry form. Please indicate the High Point(s) for which you wish to be considered.

Miscellaneous: Every class offered which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Washington State Horsemen, Inc., rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance with current Northwest Border Zone rules.

Showmanship and trail will count for the high point discipline in which they are shown. For example, points from showmanship will count for the Western high point if shown in western tack and appointment, and the English high point if shown in English tack and appointment.

The decision of the judge is final. No one shall approach the judge with regard to a decision unless he/she first obtains permission from the show committee & steward, who shall arrange an appointment at a proper time and place.

Protests must be in writing, signed, and addressed to the show secretary, received by the show manager within 48 hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation and be accompanied by a \$100.00 deposit, which is forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEMSELVES AND THEIR HORSES.

AGREEMENT: Every entry at a Recognized Competition constitutes an agreement that the person making it, be that owner, lessee, trainer, manager agent, coach, driver, rider, or handler, and the horse are subject to the Bylaws and Rules of NWSC. Every exhibitor, rider, driver, or handler, coach and trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver, or handler under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. If any of the above persons fails to do so, his/her first entrance into the warm up arena as an exhibitor, rider, driver, or handler shall be construed as his/her acceptance of the rules of the competition involved and of NWSC and shall ipso facto render him/her subject to said rule. Upon the failure of an owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler, coach, or agent(s), parent or guardian or trainer of a minor rider, driver, or handler to sign an entry blank as required, and upon confirmation of any such violation(s) by the Steward or Secretary of the competition, such person(s) shall be subject to a fine of \$50.00, imposed for such violation.
